The SSF is also working towards long-term rehabilitation of daily wage earners, who are likely to be unemployed for an unforeseen period due to the pandemic.

They conducted a survey recently and identified households that are in desperate need of help - like families of ice-cream walas, garland makers, waste collectors, etc.

Under the current circumstances, the lowest strata of the society, comprising of daily wage workers, construction workers, contract laborers, street vendors have been the worst hit. These groups have lost the only source of their income and have no means to make ends meet or provide
